HLCol Jeannette Chau served with the 7th Toronto Regiment for 11 years, working her way up the ranks to MBdr before becoming one of the two first female officers in the Regiment. She attained the rank of Captain, the highest a female officer could reach in a combat regiment at the time. She retired from the reserves to focus on her career in Engineering, having attained a Bachelor of Applied Science degree in Electrical Engineering from the University of Toronto, and a Masters of Business Administration in Marketing and Strategic Planning from the Schulich School of Business, York University.

HLCol Chau spent 20 years in the telecom industry in progressively senior positions before moving to Professional Engineers Ontario, the licensing and regulatory body for 89,000 engineers in Ontario for the last twelve years, and has recently retired.
